## **Note:**

**Confirmed cases** (RT-PCR positive): Lock down will be effective for minimum of 21 days from the date of confirmation and isolation of the index case.

**Probable case** (IgM positive, RT-PCR negative):

- 1. Lock down will be effective for one week from the day of RDT positive of probable case.
- 2. Quarantine probable case separately at a facility for one week and test by RDT at the end of quarantine.
- 3. Collect throat swap from all primary contacts and quarantine at facility for one week.
